Born in Little Rock to Bjorn and Kathryn Massey Roset, he worked as a heating and air technician and a volunteer firefighter. Dane was utterly dependable, always selfless and a hard worker. He was a first friend to many, a great partner and teammate, and made himself a big brother to the kids around him. He gave everyone a chance, no matter who they were or what they might have done. Dane was an avid outdoorsman. He loved animals, was a fish “whisperer,” and worked as a lifeguard. He was an MMA and BJJ coach and instructor, an amateur MMA fighter and a champion BJJ fighter.
